- Abstract should be between 250 and 400 words.

Poster Guidelines

- Poster should include the following sections: Background, Methods, Results, and Conclusion.
- Poster board should be 24 inches tall by 36 inches wide.
- The author must remain by their poster board for the duration of the poster session.
- Utilize a large font size (can be read from a distance of 10-15 feet away).
